### Pupil Premium and Free School Meals

There have been some changes to the way the Pupil Premium and Free School Meal provision will be organised by the Government in the future. When families are eligible for Pupil Premium not only do children receive free school dinners but the school also receives money for each child in order to support their education in school and ensure they receive an enriched learning experience. The changes will mean that any family currently eligible for Free School Meals and Pupil Premium will remain eligible until **31st March 2022**. We would like to encourage families who have not completed a form to do so and check their eligibility for Free School Meals. Forms are available from the school office. Thank you.
