William Morris have had a amazing year so far. With all this fantastic learning and our Spotlight on Sport, things just couldn't get any better!

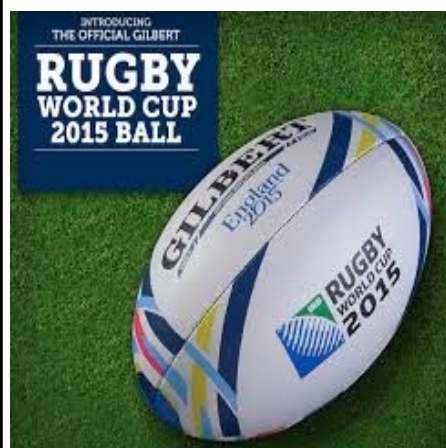
This half-term, we have been focussing on
